Voting will take place at the office located at 1010 Hinton Road, Bethpage and 185 Hwy 25W Castalian Springs you may cast your vote between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

Any customer of the Castalian Springs-Bethpage Utility District is eligible to qualify and run for the position by filing a petition with at least ten active customers' signatures. One signature for one tap. Petitions are available at the Bethpage office. The completed petition must be return by September 20th, 2024 for verification. The ballot will be official on September 21th for the October 10th election. In an effort to encourage a larger voter response, if an account is currently in the name of a deceased person, a relative residing at the account service address may change the name of the account without charge. Also, in order to make it more convenient to vote, any customer who wishes to add the name of their spouse to their account may do so at no charge. Either of these changes must be completed before the Election Day. Please bear in mind that only one vote can be cast for one account.

In order to vote, you must be a current paying customer of the District; your account must be in good standing, not delinquent. If the account is in both husband and wife's name, only one can vote. Please bear in mind one vote can be cast for one account, if you have additional accounts you can only vote once. You must prove your eligibility to vote by <u>bringing proper identification</u>.
